Note: This tri-fold communication board was originally designed for use in an AAC workshop. This format allows the user to see *all* of the vocabulary *all* of the time. Sequencing is needed to form a sentence, but not to access vocabulary

The board is organized in a Fitzgerald Key format, that is, words are color-coded and categorized according to People (yellow), Verbs (green), Little Words (articles, prepositions, and conjunctions) (pink), Descriptive Words (Adjectives, Adverbs and Time words) (blue), Things (orange) and Places (purple).

The vocabulary for this board was selected to ensure that those participating in the training activity could use the board to take the PLS-3 and achieve a score at the 36-40 month level of expressive performance. It dos not represent a functional core lexicon. While many of these words would be included in a functional lexicon, additional words would be needed to enable the child to communicate basic needs, wants and to talk about topics of interest.
